

RAZ shower chair toilet compatibility


Standard WC- Adjusting the height of your RAZ for clearance

The table below shows the seat height setting you will need to clear the listed toilet bowl heights. It is important to make a note of the toilet bowl height when carrying out a client assessment and submitting this information when getting a quotation or ordering from core stock.

Lining up your RAZ with the toilet bowl

Getting this measurement correct is important so that the seat aperture lines up with the toilet opening. Remember to consider waste pipe location and the toilets distance from the wall.



Rearmost chair point to rear of seat aperture				
AT (attendant tilt)	290			
ATW (attendant tilt wide)	290			
ATP (attendant tilt paediatric)	230			
AP (attendant propel)	180			
AP Auto (attendant propel wide)	180			
SP (self propel)	280			
AT600 (attendant tilt bariatric)	350			
AP600 (attendant propel bariatric)	255			
SP600 (self propel bariatric)	380			

Best Practice

A common requirement is to have the skirt accessory added to the underside of the seat and the option of removing the pan sliders to provide a closer fit with the toilet. The standard moulded seat shaping contributes to a much improved wash experience.

- Obstructions around the toilet- grab handles, basins etc
- Soil stack location and direction
- Flooring and thresholds
